Council:

I am still working with the DMV and State Treasurer's office on the exact language for the BDR, however we do need council approval to submit the BDR which needs to be done before September 1st. As this is the last meeting in August I am requesting that you approve the use of the one BDR allocated to the City to once again request DMV services. As I stated we do not currently have exact language as I'm still working to finalize that with the DMV. But what we will likely request is just the final language from SB 65 from the 2019 session which would provide funding to the DMV for their rural travel program as well as funding for software & training of city staff to allow them to process vehicle registrations and other basic DMV functions. Which is similar to what many of the rural County Recorders currently do. This program would not add much additional work to staff only occasional renewals but would begin the process of getting more long-term & expanded DMV services in our community. The reason I believe it's best to stick with the language of SB65 is because it passed unanimously in the Senate & had it not ran out of time would've passed unanimously in the Assembly and likely been signed by Governor Sisolak. I have also attached SB65 for your reference.

Sec. 2. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of \$12,437 for the costs of creating an electronic connection between the Department and the City Hall in the City of West Wendover to provide vehicle registration services in the City of West Wendover.

2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2020, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 18, 2020, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 18, 2020.

Sec. 3. The appropriations made by the provisions of this act are not intended to finance ongoing expenditures of state agencies, and the expenditures financed with those appropriations must be included as base budget expenditures in the proposed budget for the Executive Branch of State Government for the 2021-2023 biennium.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval for the purposes of performing any preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this act, and on July 1, 2019, for all other purposes.
